

The Future Ready PA Index is a collection of school progress measures related to school and student success. The Index includes a range of assessment, on-track, and readiness indicators, to more accurately report student learning, growth, and success in the classroom and beyond. FUTURE READY PA INDEX What data is available? (by district and by school)

- Demographics
- Student Groups
- Student Performance
 - State Assessment Measures (Achievement and Growth)
 - On-Track Measures (EL, Attendance, Early Indicators of Success)
 - College and Career Measures (Career Standards Benchmarks)



FUTURE READY PA INDEX How is Progress Measured?



--Achievement and Growth --By current and previous performance comparison --Progress towards goal/standard

- meets or exceeds statewide goal
- meets or exceeds interim target
- not meeting goal/target
- (insufficient info or not applicable)



What is proficiency rate (achievement)?

% students scoring a proficient or advanced achievement level on their state assessments

What is Growth?

The PVAAS Growth Index is converted to a 50-100 point scale. PA Value-Added Assessment System is a statistical analysis used to measure LEA/districts', schools' and teachers' influence on the academic progress rates of groups of students from year to year.

PVAAS also provides indicators of success on future assessments for individual students.



What is Growth?

A value-added growth measure is calculated in the following manner: GROWTH=CURRENT ACHIEVEMENT compared to all prior achievement (on PSSA and/or Keystones Exams)

Achievement vs. Growth

- Achievement is about location—Growth is about direction
- Achievement measures a student's performance at one single point in time and compares student performance to a standard (often highly correlated to a student's demographics)
- Growth measures student's academic performance across time and compares to their own prior performance

ELA Proficiency Rate (& Growth)

Science Proficiency Rate (& Growth)

Blain69.8% (75)Carroll84.9% (52)New Bloomfield70.4% (50)WPMS64.2% (73)WPHS59.7% (69)
