

Future Ready Index Analysis Identified Strengths

Keystone Literature Achievement

- The All Student group achieved proficient/advanced at 81.3% which met the 2033 Statewide goal of 81.1% on the Literature Keystone Exam.
- The All Student group exceeded the standard demonstrating growth.
- Students with disabilities group student growth exceeded the statewide growth standard and the statewide average on Keystone Literature Exams.
- Economically Disadvantaged student groups are achieving proficiency levels higher than the state average. Additionally, this subgroup exceeded the statewide growth standard and statewide average growth score.

Future Ready Index Analysis Identified Strengths (continued)

Four Year Graduation Cohort: West Perry Senior High School

The *All Student* Group graduation rate of 89.6% met the Interim Goal/Improvement Target and exceeded the statewide average of 87.0%

Industry-Based Learning: West Perry Senior

<u>High School</u>

44.3% of all students earned at least one indicator of industrybased learning. This is higher than the performance standard of 30.7% and the statewide average of 32.8%.

Future Ready Index Analysis Identified Strengths (continued)

PSSA ELA , Math, Science: West Perry Middle School

The *All Student* Group met the Standard demonstrating growth in all three areas (ELA, Math, Science)

<u>Career Standards Benchmark: All 3</u> <u>elementary schools and West Perry High</u> School

All student groups exceeded the performance standard for career standards. All 3 elementary schools were at 100% and the high school was at 98.7% Future Ready Index Analysis Identified Challenges

- Regular Attendance
- Achievement and Growth on Keystone Exams Biology and Algebra
- Achievement & Growth on PSSA Math/ELA/Science Grades 3-5 (inconsistent)
- Achievement in Math/ELA/Science in Grades 6-8

2024-2027 WPSD Comprehensive Plan Priorities

1. Development of a standards-aligned Pre-K-12 district curriculum for all students via a transparent curriculum platform that communicates clear learning targets to all stakeholders.

2. Commitment to a comprehensive professional learning plan to support the implementation of effective instructional practices and family engagement in all schools.

2024-2027 WPSD Comprehensive Plan 3-Year Targets

1. A platform for all Pre-K through **12** curricula will be available for instructional staff and a five-year curriculum cycle implemented to ensure that all areas of the curricula are reviewed on a cyclical basis.

2. Student achievement will increase by providing focused, job-embedded professional learning on designing rigorous and engaging classroom experiences that remove barriers to student learning and family engagement.

Action Plan (continuous process)

- 1. Core Curriculum Team will develop a curricular vision and design a strategic process to ensure district-wide coherence in the following:
 - Curriculum Platform
 - Templates
 - Curriculum Committee and Developer Selection
 - Professional Learning to ensure highquality units for each department/subject/grade level
 - Elementary ELA, Secondary Math, STEELS (Science, Technology & Engineering and Environmental Literacy and Sustainability)

Action Plan (continuous process) 2. The instructional leadership team will collaborate to create a professional learning plan for all staff throughout our learning organization in the areas of engaging instruction, rigorous learning, data analysis, and school culture.

- Consistent, coherent
- Professional Learning for leadership
- Principal-led Professional Learning for teachers/staff
- Commitment to intentional professional learning (time and resources)
- School Improvement Survey administered to students, parents, and staff annually
